

Susan Cummins Gallery Collection

Historical Note

The Susan Cummins Gallery was founded in 1983 in Mill Valley, California. Specializing in contemporary American art jewelry, the gallery notably melded the distinct worlds of fine art and craft.

Scope and Content

The collection contains press clippings related to Featured Artists, exhibitions, the Susan Cummins Gallery, and Cummins herself. Also included are correspondence with Cummins, slides of exhibitions and installations at the gallery, one photograph of an exhibition, and articles by Marcia Tanner. The articles include no mention of Susan Cummins or the Gallery.
